In a signing ceremony between Al Jazeera and the IPI, Dr Mostefa Souag, Al

Jazeera's Acting Director General, commented, "As part of our ongoing commitment to press freedom, Al Jazeera is delighted to be hosting this milestone event alongside our colleagues at IPI. It's especially important that this event will be held in the Middle East as this is something that will help further the cause of press freedom and the improvement of standards in the region."

The 2015 IPI World Congress will be held in Yangon, Myanmar from 27 to 29 March. Previous congresses have been held in Cape Town, South Africa (April, 2014), Amman, Jordan (May, 2013) and Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago (June, 2012).
