

Applications for web design bursaries now open

Lectures for the diploma commence on 22 February 2016.

“We are looking for individuals who want to gain a world class qualification in web design and web development,” says Darren Fox, director of the Institute. “Applicants need a decent matric, a passion for IT, design and the web and they must be self-driven to work by themselves and have a strong wish to succeed.”

The web design and development field continues to be one of the most exciting and lucrative industries in the world. Due to the expansion of e-commerce, it is anticipated that internationally there will be a 20% employment growth for web developers by 2022, with similar job growth prospects in South Africa.

South African companies are paying, on average, R153,822 per year for a web developer. In the USA, the BLS report of 2014 claims that Web developers made a median salary of \$63,160.

Concept Interactive Institute also offers short courses throughout the year including print media design and Ruby on Rails Programme. By keeping the classes small, students receive personal attention and hands-on guidance throughout their studies.
